All the best for the new year!

Basserk Records kicks off 2008 with a new 12" (vinyl): **'Split 1'**

The **'split series'** is a new concept Basserk is using in 2008 for new releases. It's pretty simple: a record has got 2 sides and we're gonna use them in a different way than before (we didn't invent the concept but it's new for us, just like 2008). We will use both sides as if they were both A-sides. On both sides, a different band/producer will present 2 or 3 of his/hers/their best tracks. The nice thing about this concept is that we can release 2 bands/artists at the same time, and you also get two front sleeves with nice artwork from our favourite designers 310k.

On the first in our new 'Split series' you will find 2 fat electro tracks by **\$jammie the money (NL)** and 3 bleep-electro-distortion tracks from **Genjini (F)**.

Producer and DJ **\$jammie the money**, whom some of you might already know as the DJ from the band 'Nobody beats the drum', has only just started his solo project '**\$jammie the money**', but it sounds like he's already been doing it for years. Track 1, 'Getting warm', starts off like this: fat, pumping, pumping, pumping electro that grabs you by the balls and doesn't let go. Track 2 'Dollars' carries on the same energy that made us happy in the first track, with a fat wicked!! boom, boom, boom, boom. For 2008, keep your eyes and ears on mister \$jammie the money cause you're gonna hear a lot more of this bloke.

The french group **Genjini** has played a few times in Amsterdam on Basserk parties and had a track on our compilation CD 'Some Tunes'. They're no strangers any more for anyone who's been watching Basserk or living in France. Now they're back with 3 tracks on the first 'Split' of Basserk. All tracks breath that typical Genjini sound, weird, full of energy, bleepy, screetchy, scratchy and with enough power to make your grandma jump around. Short but powerful french bleep-electro with a strange eccentric twist.

Keep an eye on both artists cause you'll hear loads more about them this year. You'll soon hear from Basserk again, because 'Split 2' is almost finished.
