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Basserk Records kicked 2008 off with a 12" (vinyl), called: '**Split 1**'. That was only a few weeks ago, now we're back again with the next one: '**Split 2**'.

As explained before, the '**Split Series**' is about using two sides to the max! Forget about side A and B, we have 2 times side A. In this case (in random order!): 3 fat electropunk-tracks from **Three cheers for dirty (F)** + 3 tropielectro-tracks van **Lucky Goat (NL)**.

The french band '**Three cheers for dirty**' performed in Amsterdam for the first time during the Amsterdam Dance Event last year (2007). That was in the OT301 at the Basserk label party. You don't have to be a genius to hear that 'Miss Wendy pussy' and 'Dsildah' were influenced by garage/rock/punk/tekno for years. They have that dirty, rough punky sound with fat beats and distorted vocals. Not the kind of tracks you will play on your average sunday morning...

On the other A-side: **Lucky Goat** from Amsterdam. They are no strangers to us, but they might be to you. Both of them were members of 3-1, those other Basserkers. For a few years now they've performed under the name Lucky Goat - this is their debut record. Yeah, how can one describe this music: it aint electro, it aint acid, it aint reggae and it aint no hiphop. Let's call it electronic music with a 'tropical breeze'. Maybe it would be better to check it out yourself.
