Basserk Records releases a new 12" (vinyl): **'Take a picture'**
5 wicked pistolpop/electropunk tracks from **'3-1'**

This is already the third release from Basserk records. The first one was the 12" (vinyl) 'don't destroy' from 3-1. The second one was the compilation cd 'some tunes', Thanks to the distribution from Lowlands.be, the first release is as good as sold out and the second going well. All tracks are digitally distributed by EPM-online and now available on I-tunes and other mp3/web stores. This means Basserk tracks can be bought worldwide!!!

After their first release (end of 2005) 3-1, has performed a lot of live shows on festivals and in clubs in several different countries. The highlights were the performance at the Dour festival (Belgium) and the minitour through Japan. At the Dour festival 3-1, was the closing act on Friday night in a fully packed tent with about 5000 people going insane. Japan was a nice adventure and the people really seem to like the pistolpop madness from 3-1, so in 2007 3-1 will return for more.

On this release there are 5 different but fat new tracks. The first one 'Take a picture' has got that raw, pumping pistolpop sound that we know from 3-1. The second track 'Sweat is drippin' has a similar energy level but in a different way. Side B starts with 'In the basement': guitar samples and distorted vocals make the very raw sound for this track with hit potential. The second track is completely different, it's almost a whistle-along summer tune that gets stuck in your head after hearing it twice. The last one is called 'Boyband': it's: pump, poink, pump, poink! The imaginary number six 'Living in the dark' is free for download on the Basserk website (www.basserk.com).

2007 starts great for 3-1 and Basserk but there is a lot more to come.
